

The **Bishop Miege Board of Trustees** are members of the community, approved by the Archbishop, to manage the activities of the school. In 2010, each high school in Johnson County became their own not-for-profit corporation, with the Board of Trustees responsible for ensuring the mission of the school is consistent with the Catholic Church and the school's finances and assets are managed appropriately. In addition, the Board of Trustees is responsible for hiring a President. Each Trustee serves a three-year term with a maximum of two consecutive terms.







Dear Miege Friends,

"I don't have to worry about Bishop Miege because they come to me with solutions to challenges rather than problems." These words were stated by Archbishop Naumann this past November to those gathered at our 25th Foundation Dinner. We have hosted

this event every year since 1995 with one of the purposes being to thank and recognize members of the Miege community for their exceptional stewardship. Archbishop Naumann made his remarks at the end of the evening and just after the update of Bridge to the Future. The Archbishop was referring to the leadership provided by the Bishop Miege Foundation Board for their service in guiding our school through many challenging times. Since 1992 the group has come up with solutions to serious issues involving facility decline, the opening of two new Catholic high schools and tuition affordability for our families.

"The Foundation has saved Bishop Miege High School" is another comment Archbishop Naumann has made on previous occasions. Over the past 27 years Foundation Board members have overseen three major capital campaigns and the acquisition of the north campus. These projects have given our students and staff a campus that is on par with any metro Catholic High School. And now, with the Foundation leading the way, we are close to establishing a scholarship program (Bridge to the Future) with an endowment like no other in the area that will annually provide tuition support for over 220 students for decades to come.

Financial support for these initiatives have totaled over \$40 million. These accomplishments were made possible by the vision of the Foundation Board in union with the countless alumni, current and past parents and friends who have so generously supported these projects.

There are many reasons Bishop Miege is an exceptional Catholic high school. One of those reasons is definitely because of the leadership of both the current and past Foundation members-- listed on this page.

Our school community has been truly blessed by the dedication and commitment of these individuals in securing a bright future for our school. On behalf of all of our families-past, present and future-- we thank them for all they have done in support of providing the very best Catholic education for our students.

STAG STRUT

Miege students collect pledge donations in support of their education by taking part in the annual Stag Strut. The school-wide event generates revenue to help off-set the more than \$1,000 difference between the actual cost of education vs. tuition. The students reached their goal of \$60,000 with 95% participation. It was a great day for students and faculty alike, while at the same time, helping raise the necessary funds for the school at the same time.

MAGAZINE & COOKIE DOUGH SALE

The Bishop Miege Annual Magazine and Cookie Dough Sale kicked off on January. Credit goes to the diligence of Miege students, families and staff who worked to raise \$37,688. Through buying and renewing magazines or purchasing cookie dough during this campaign, we acknowledge your continued support of Bishop Miege and its programs.

STAG SHOP

College Readiness

At Bishop Miege we have implemented a STREAM curriculum with the integration of Religion and the Arts into STEM content areas. STREAM responds to career readiness for the current generation. A cross-integration of curriculum for deeper learning with technology and collaboration, merging 21st century teaching and learning with the timeless truths of faith and beauty in all of the subject areas.

STREAM is not a new curriculum, nor is it a specific subject. STREAM is a creative method of teaching a concept across a variety of subjects. STREAM uses technology to advance the experience. Not only do students use traditional text, but use white boards, Smartboards, laptops and collaboration to process and learn.

Working in creative spaces and working outside the standard scope and sequence of every day classroom STREAM challenges the way teachers teach and more importantly, how students learn. Rather than passively absorbing lecture material to repeat back during the next test, STREAM learners delve into the unknown, asking questions and seeking answers that are real and relevant to their lives so that they are better prepared for life beyond high school.



Interdisciplinary and applied approaches to Science, Technology, Religion, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics with creative collaborative spaces.

As a Catholic school, our mission is to educate the whole student; therefore, taking the principles of STEM infusing Religion, and adding the arts to provide students the creative thinking skills necessary to communicate and advance in the real world.



The new math hub located in the Kincaid Media Center is a place for students to go throughout the day for enrichment with a Math teacher for all levels of math. The quiet space allows for collaboration for students to work on projects and share expertise.

SCHOLARSHIP FOR THE 21ST CENTURY

The Senior Class of 1990 initiated the class gift idea to invest money into Miege. They collected from their classmates along with donations from the Student Council to provide scholarships for future students. The senior classes since then have continued donating to the scholarship fund. With the participation from 1990 through 2018, the current scholarship fund is \$676,199.

Stag Achievement



Charlie Hill scored a perfect score of 36 on the ACT exam as a Junior. This is the first time a student has obtained a perfect score in 36 years. He is a well-rounded student participating in cross country, debate, forensics, robotics, Page Pirates, Scholar's Bowl and is a member of National Honors Society.



Katie Taylor was recently named a Commended student in the 2019 National Merit Scholarship program. Commended students placed among the top 50,000 scorers of more than 1.6 million students who entered by taking the 2018 Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying test.



STATE DEBATE The 2020 Stags Debate team placed 2nd this year at the State tournament. It was a tight match with a 12-2 record and 31 ballots; Paola was 1st with a 12-2 record and 32 ballots.



The Fall musical, Singin' In the Rain was a huge hit for the sold out shows that took place in the fall. This years' musical was more challenging with all the dance numbers being tap. Most of the students had never tapped before but with a lot of time, effort, and prepration the cast pulled off the dance numbers with ease.



EMBRACEing Miege A new "Go Stags Go!" Snack Shop has opened by our special needs students that are part of an Entrepreneurship class. The students fill orders and deliver the snacks to teachers during 4th hour. The students also sold handmade Christmas cards during the holiday season.

With funding from *EMBRACE, the program is overseen by Miege's new Learning Resource Director, Mallorie Hurlbert. She is a 2003 alum with two Master's degrees from the University of Kansas, obtaining her license in Social Work and Educational Leadership.

The mission of EMBRACE is to provide children with special needs the opportunity for an inclusive education by providing the resources to support these children in their home parish schools.

HERB ROME STEWARDSHIP AWARD

Among the highlights of the 25th Annual Bishop Miege Foundation Dinner on November 2, 2019, was the presentation of the Herbert Rome Stewardship Award.

The Foundation established the Herb Rome Stewardship Award in memory of Herb's commitment to Miege beginning in 1955 when he worked on the campaign to build Miege and continued in many capacities up to his passing nine years ago.

The 2019 recipient was John Latenser, who was recognized for his longtime, exceptional commitment to Bishop Miege High School. John has been a leader in a countless number of campaigns and fundraising efforts for over 24 years. He and his wife Mary remain active in their commitment to the students at Miege, years after their children have graduated, JP ('99), Stephen ('01), Elizabeth ('02) and Leah ('06).

ALUMNI OF THE YEAR

The Bishop Miege Alumni of the Year Award is presented to a graduate who has given his or her time, talents and loyalty to enhance Bishop Miege and its traditions.
